<b>Introduces oneself and profession</b> to resident/family	
Verify the <b>resident's identity</b> using two identifiers (e.g., name and date of birth)	
Explain <b>reason for interview</b>	
Asks about name and contact information of the <b>community pharmacies</b>	
Asks opening questions related to adherence	
Asks about resident's <b>prescription medications</b> : verifies medication name, dose, route, frequency, rationale for use	
Asks about <b>recent changes</b> to resident's medications and why	
Asks about is using any <b>non-prescription medications</b> : verifies name, dose, route, frequency, rationale	
Asks about using any <b>vitamins</b>	
Asks about using any <b>minerals</b>	
Asks about using any <b>supplements</b>	
Asks about using any <b>eye/ear drops</b>	
Asks about using any <b>nose drops or sprays</b>	
Asks about using any <b>inhalers/sprays</b>	
Asks about using any <b>medicated patches</b>	
Asks about using any <b>medicated creams or ointments</b>	
Asks about using any <b>injectable medications</b>	
Asks about receiving medication <b>samples</b> recently	
Asks about has recently <b>received a course of antibiotics/antivirals</b> in past approximately 3 months	
Asks about <b>natural health products/complementary medicines</b>	
Asks about <b>cannabis</b>	
Asks about <b>lifestyle products/substances</b>	
Asks if resident has any <b>allergies/severe side effects</b>
